EXPULSION

The Provincial Government of the Eastern Province,

Having regard to the fundamental law of May 19, 1960 relating to the structures of the Congo;

Having regard to the decree of 27 December 1948 on immigration policing as amended to date and in particular by that of 24 December 1959, especially in its articles 14, 19, 22 and 23;

Whereas Mr. EMMANUEL Arghiri, born in Patras, (Greece), on July 22, 1911, holder of the status of permanent resident, is undesirable and by his presence and conduct compromises and threatens to further compromise tranquility and public order;

Whereas it is undesirable on the basis of information received from the Belgian Government and foreign Governments;

Whereas through his subversive activities, his declarations and speeches he constitutes a threat to the internal and external security of the Republic of Congo, to tranquility and public order;

Whereas in particular by his activities he is attempting to place the Republic of Congo under the direct or indirect domination of a foreign Government; that to do so he has, among other things, helped to foment unrest, create and maintain a state of mind in rebellion against legal powers, provoke the excitement of law enforcement against their hierarchical superiors and established powers;

Whereas the person concerned is a permanent resident and an expulsion measure can only be taken after advice from the advisory Commission provided for this purpose;

Whereas, nevertheless, the Provincial Government considers it necessary, in the current situation, for the protection of public order and the security of the Republic of Congo, to put the person concerned out of harm's way and consequently to place him immediately at the disposal of the government during the procedure before the consultative commission on expulsions;

Given the urgency,

Arrest :

Single item

Mr. EMMANUEL Arghiri, permanent resident awaiting expulsion, is placed at the disposal of the government for the duration of the expulsion procedure.

He will be immediately incarcerated at Stanleyville Central Prison.
